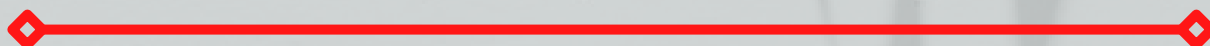


Fra Presidenten

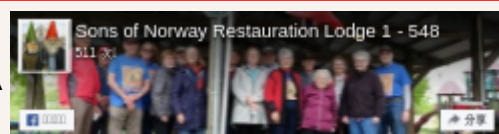

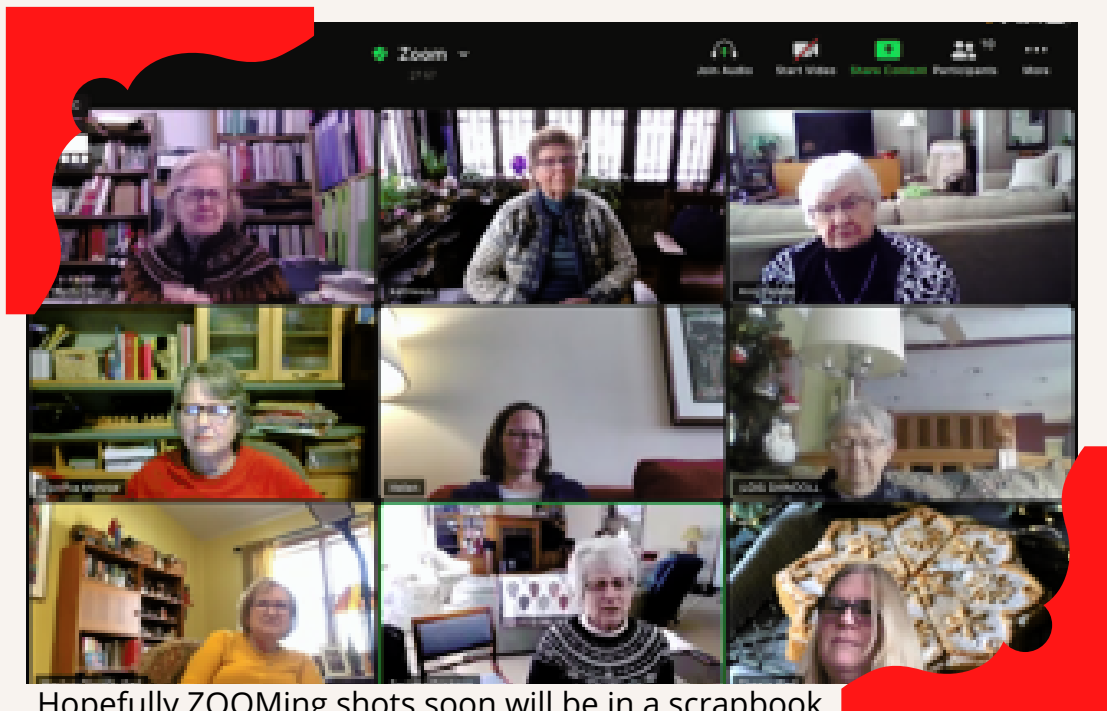

Oldest printed book in Norway

The year is 1643. King Christian IV of Denmark and his officials have succeeded in "Dane-ifying" Norway: runes have been replaced by Latin letters and Old Norse by Danish.

Parish priest Christen Steffensen Bang in Romedal in Eastern Norway persuades the 33-year-old Danish book printer Tyge Nielssen to move his business northwards from Copenhagen to Norway and Christiania (Oslo).

The first Nielssen prints are two small theological writings. Then he decided to produce the Almanac for 1644 with the full title: "En Ny Allmanach paa det Aar efter Jesu Christi Fødsel 1644. Christiania Aff Tyge Nielssen" (English: "New Almanac for the Year after the Birth of Jesus Christ 1644. Christiania by Tyge Nielssen").
